

CBI Searches AAP Leader Durgesh Pathak's Residence Amid Foreign Funding Probe

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) conducted a raid at the home of Durgesh Pathak, a former Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) MLA, on Thursday, a development that has sparked political controversy. A complaint has been filed against him in connection with the action, which is connected to alleged violations of the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA). According to CBI sources, Pathak, who is currently the AAP's co-incharge for Gujarat, is accused of irregularities involving foreign dona-

tions. Although the specifics of the alleged infractions have not been made public, the action has already provoked political criticism. AAP MP Sanjay Singh responded to the raid on social media, condemning the action and charging the national government, led by the BJP, with abusing investigative agencies for political ends. On X (previously Twitter), Singh commented, "BJP's dirty game starts again." "The CBI has arrived at Gujarat's co-incharge @ipathak25's residence. The Modi administration has made every

effort to dismantle the Aam Aadmi Party, but it has failed. Gujarat's BJP situation is precarious. CBI was dispatched to threaten @ipathak25 as soon as he was named co-incharge. Tension has increased as a result of the raid's timing, which came just after Pathak was appointed to a crucial party position in Gujarat. AAP leaders have described it as a politically motivated attempt to impede their operations in the state. The CBI has not yet released any formal announcements regarding the raid's results.

Talking about the impact of terrorism in Pakistan, he said, "Do you think terrorists can take away the destiny of the country? The 1.3 million-strong Indian Army, with all its whereabouts, if they cannot intimidate

us, do you think these terrorists can subdue the armed forces of Pakistan?" He also sent a warning to the terror elements in Balochistan, where a train hijacked passenger train travelling from Quetta to Peshawar last month, the Pakistan Army will defeat all such forces soon. Munir added: "Balochistan is Pakistan's pride, you will just take it away so easily? You won't be able to take it in 10 generations. Inshallah, we will defeat these terrorists very soon. Pakistan will not fall." Speaking about Kashmir, General Munir said, "Our stance is absolutely clear, it was our jugular vein, it will be our jugular vein, we will not forget it. We will not leave our Kashmiri brothers in their heroic struggle." However, India is yet to respond to the Kashmir row. Time and again, New Delhi has said that Kashmir is an integral part of India. The relations between the two countries has nosived since the BJP government abrogated the Article 370 in 2019.

Pakistan Army Chief General Asim Munir has once again raked up the Kashmir issue by claiming that no power in the world can separate the disputed territory from his country. Addressing a gathering, Munir boasted that people should not forget that they belong to a "superior ideology and culture" while defending the two-nation theory, which led to the partition of India and Pakistan in 1947. He said: "You should definitely tell Pakistan's story to your children. Our forefathers thought that we are different from the Hindus in every aspect of life. Our religions, our cus-

Mamata Slams Modi For Double Standards On Muslim Hospitality, Urges INDIA Bloc Unity

Regarding the Waqf Amendment Act, West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee sharply criticized Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). She said that the ruling party was "against Muslims" while Muslim-majority countries were welcoming her. Speaking to a group of Muslim clerics, Banerjee drew attention to what she saw as a contradiction in the BJP's position. In reference to the Prime Minister's trips to West Asian nations, she said, "You are against Muslims in India, but when you go to Saudi Arabia or Dubai, whose hospitality do you take?" According to Banerjee, the BJP's foreign policy was inconsistent with its domestic rhetoric. Banerjee called on the opposition INDIA group to



"stay united and fight together" in their resistance to the Waqf Amendment Act. She emphasized that the issue would affect others in the future and was not limited to the Muslim community. It's against you today. It might be against someone else tomorrow. She cautioned, "Now they want to bring the Uniform Civil Code (UCC)." Banerjee's remarks followed recent violence in West Bengal's Murshidabad during a Muslim


community demonstration against the Waqf Amendment Act. On April 11, the demonstrations descended into violence, killing a father and son and injuring numerous others. One more person was killed as police opened fire to bring the situation under control. A Special Investigation Team (SIT) has been established by the West Bengal Police in response to the violence to look into the happenings. Senior officers from a variety of units, including as the Counter Insurgency Force (CIF) and the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), will be part of the SIT in order to look into what caused the disturbance and make sure the victims receive justice.

A new article from a reputed national media house describes the case of an Indian man whose U.S. tourist visa was denied after he honestly told the visa officer that he was planning to visit his girlfriend in Florida. The visa officer ended up rejecting the application based on this one single answer, it seems. Despite having no previous international travel history and claim-



ing he was only visiting for tourism, he was issued a 214(b) refusal. This typically means the applicant failed to prove strong enough ties to their home country, raising concerns that they may not return after their visit. The incident sparked debate on Reddit, with many Indians discussing how

being too honest in a visa interview can backfire. While honesty is important, visa officers are trained to assess risk based on specific factors such as travel history, financial stability, and personal or professional ties to the home country. It is primarily being established that citing a romantic relationship in the U.S. without demonstrating solid reasons to return to India can create the impression of a possible intent to overstaying. Experts advise applicants to be truthful but also answer only what is asked, and avoid volunteering extra information unless necessary. Showing strong connections to India through a job, family, or property can improve the chances of visa approval, it is being established.

Telugu Student Killed in Texas Hit-and-Run

Elon Musk's Team Eyes 'Gold Card' Visa Market

Donald Trump's dream project, the Gold Card, is set to hit the markets within a week or ten days. Commerce Secretary Howard Lutnick announced this development, highlighting the project's readiness for sales. This initiative is part of Trump's broader vision, unveiled shortly after his second term inauguration, offering a unique pathway to American citizenship for affluent immigrants. The Gold Card serves as the cornerstone of this exclusive program. Elon Musk, the head of the Department of Government Efficiency, is playing a pivotal role in the Gold Card's development. Engineers from Musk's team are crafting the application process, ensuring a seamless experience for potential buyers.
