Visa Slots Vanished: Indian Students In Roadblock



The prevailing situation in the United States of America for the students from the Indian community is already pathetic to say the least. There are a lot of scrutinise that are being done with visa renewal and on top of that several strict measures are being enforced to cut down new issuance of visas. In this context, something strange unexpected has happened. Overnight, several hundreds of visas slots got vanished on the United States portal, and this has become a topic of concern for the Indian student community. Thousands of Indian students are facing uncertainty as U.S. student visa interview slots have suddenly disappeared across major Indian cities, especially Ahmedabad. Until mid-March 2025, students were able to book interviews for April, but no new slots have opened for May. This has left many students, who already received admission letters and I-20 forms from U.S. universities, in limbo. The situation contrasts sharply with the smooth visa process for the January 2025 intake. Experts believe the sudden slot unavailability may be linked to recent crackdowns by the U.S. embassy in India. Visa consultants say they haven't seen such widespread unavailability before, causing concern among aspiring students. Hyderabad has also witnessed a similar issue, with over 10,000 F-1 visa slots getting booked within just five minutes of release. This overwhelming demand is making it nearly impossible for many students to secure appointments in time for the upcoming academic session.

TCS Comes Under U.S. Radar: Why And How?

The United States administration is going particularly hard against immigration policies and also the equal employment regulations that are in effect in the country. This restriction has now landed Indian software giant TCS in trouble with the United States equal employment department, and here is a detailed look into this story. Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), India's largest IT services company, is currently under investigation by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission for alleged discriminatory employment practices. The inquiry stems from over two dozen complaints filed since late 2023, accusing TCS of unfairly laying off American workers while primarily non-South Asians aged over 40 while retaining younger Indian employees on H-1B visas. Former

employees claim they were replaced by less experienced and lower-paid Indian workers, and some allege they were blocked from internal job opportunities within the company. These accusations have raised serious concerns about the potential misuse of the H-1B visa program and discrimination based on age and nationality. TCS has strongly denied all allegations, calling them "meritless and misleading," and reaffirmed its commitment to fair employment practices in the U.S. The controversy has sparked political attention as well. U.S. Representative Seth Moulton has urged a formal probe,



and similar complaints have emerged in the UK, adding international pressure. If the United States government finds any malpractices with regard to partial and favoured imposition of employment opportunities, the TCS could find itself in huge trouble. For now, only an investigation has been proved, and the facts regarding the case are being established.

Airfares from India to US Drop Ahead of Summer Travel Boom

In a notable shift in travel trends, airfare from India to the United States has seen a significant decrease, making international travel more accessible than in recent years. Specifically, for trips planned in May 2025, travelers from Mumbai to the US can find one-way tickets for as low as ₹37,000, and round-trip fares beginning at ₹76,000. This reduction is part of a larger trend observed during the April to June 2025 quarter, where travel platforms have reported an average fare decrease of 5-8% compared to the same period in 2024. This change comes as a welcome development for Indian families looking to travel during the summer holiday season, a time when demand for long-haul destinations like the US traditionally peaks.


nessed a notable price drop in tickets, with fares to cities such as Boston, Orlando, and Michigan decreasing to around ₹1.35 lakh from the previous year's range of ₹1.40–₹1.45 lakh.

For those with flexible travel dates, the opportunity to secure even more economical fares exists, particularly for flights that include layovers in Middle Eastern hubs or routes through Delhi or London with a transit time of less than four hours, priced around ₹85,000. For the last couple of weeks, there have been several discussions about the kind of outages that are being observed in the UPI transactions. GST on UPI transactions? Centre Issues Clarity!

It is already known that the President of United States, Donald Trump has been going particularly hard against the International student community. He has largely tightened the visa restrictions and also the revenue streams of the students in the United States. In this context, an Indian student has somehow managed to win a court case against the visa restrictions that are being imposed by the Donald Trump administration. A recent court victory has brought attention to the U.S. government's tightening of student visa policies, particularly impacting Indian students. Krish Lal Isserda Sani, a 21-year-old Indian engineering student at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, was at the center of the case after his F-1 visa was abruptly revoked



without notice or any criminal charges. A federal judge intervened, temporarily halting his deportation and preventing the Department of Homeland Security from canceling his visa or detaining him. This case highlights growing concerns about due process in visa revocations, especially as the U.S. government has reportedly revoked over 4,700

SEVIS records since January 2025 with nearly half involving Indian nationals. The reasons for these actions range from minor offenses like traffic violations to participation in peaceful campus protests. Legal experts and student advocacy groups argue that these measures are often sudden, lack transparency, and give students no chance to respond or appeal. As legal pushback intensifies, the situation has sparked debate around immigration fairness and the need for clearer, more just policies for international students in the U.S. But the issue here is that such pushback's are only going to frustrate Trump further and instate him to take harder measures. This could have a lot of consequences in the due course.

cost-effective and convenient travel routes. India's position as a high-demand market for US-bound travel is reinforced by its large immigrant population and the increasing number of Indian students attending American universities. Despite historical challenges such as limited direct connectivity and longer flight durations due to airspace restrictions, the recent fare reductions mark a significant shift in the landscape of international travel for Indian passengers.

An airline official highlighted past challenges, noting, "In recent years, US-bound fares remained high year-round. Even after India resumed international flights in March 2022 post-pandemic, the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict forced carriers to avoid Russian airspace, resulting in longer routes. This, coupled with US carriers scaling back direct flights from Indian metros, kept fares elevated." Thankfully, the situation has begun to improve, with some direct flights resuming, although non-stop options are still limited.

The current dip in airfares is anticipated to persist in the short term, providing a sigh of relief for those traveling to the US for education, tourism, or family visits. Indiver Rastogi, President and Group Head, Global Business Travel, Thomas Cook (India) and SOTC Travel, encapsulated the sentiment, stating, "Summer is peak holiday season for Indian families, with schools shut and many opting for long-haul trips to destinations like the US. This year, we've observed a 5-8% drop in fares from Delhi and Mumbai to major US cities during April to June." Consequently, this period marks an opportune moment for travelers to take advantage of the lower prices, whether for leisure or academic purposes. In conclusion, the recent drop in airfares from major Indian cities to the US is a significant development in international travel, offering more Indians the opportunity to explore, study, or reconnect with family in the United States.
